You'll get far using the local bus and trains. Download the app 'AtB' to plan you travel and buy tickets. The local city bike app is called 'Trondheim Bysykkel'.

APARTMENT

The apartment is fully equipped with bed sheets and towels, cooking supplies (including a french press, kettle, pots and pans and a hand blender). Please do not remove anything from the apartment during your stay.

And remember that it is strictly forbidden to smoke inside.

CLEANING

Laundry room

Downstairs, on the south/left side of the building you will find a laundry room, feel free to use it as needed. You will find detergents next to the washing machine.

Remember to remove your clothes from the machine when they are done. If your clean clothes are left in the washing machine, the cleaner will put the clothes in a plastic box on top of the machine.

You will also find what you need to keep the apartment clean during your stay here, including a vacuum cleaner. The items in the laundry room are for all tenants and the cleaner, so remember to put any equipment you borrow back as soon as possible.


In the apartment:

Under the sink in the bathroom, you will find hand soap, toilet paper and cleaning products for the bathroom, next to the toilet you will find toilet cleaner. Please replace these when they are empty.

There is an extra set of sheets and towels in the dresser, and extra kitchen towel and kitchen cloth in the closet under the sink in the kitchen. When you clean sheets and towels, please use the program 'Daily' on 60 degrees.

Please sort your waste

- Paper, clean plastic and residual waste is sorted in separate bins, both in the apartment and in containter. Residual includes food waste.
- You will find the key for the bins on the wall in the first floor on each side of the apartment building (see image next to map).
- Glass and metal public containers (market with 'R' on map)
- Hazardous waste red box in the basement
- Please let us know if you have any waste that doesn't fit these options.





DEPARTURE CHECK LIST

Apartment

- · Make sure to tidy and clean the apartment before you leave
- · Put used towels and sheets in the laundry basket in the bathroom
- Vacuum the apartment
- Wash the toilet and the sink in the bathroom
- Empty the fridge and freezer (give/throw away)
- Take out the trash (including glass/metal)
- · Let us know if anything needs to be replaced, or is broken in any way

Studio

- Vacuum and clean floors
- Sparkle and paint walls (supplies in closet on 1st floor)
- · Throw or give away any surplus materials
- Empty trash in proper containers
- Let us know if anything is broken

FIRE INSTRUCTIONS

In apartment building (gym)

Please make sure to read the instructions available in the apartment.

In studio building

If the fire alarm goes off in the main building, please exit the building. The alarm central is located on the first floor, and you might meet other people here on your way out - if there is no actual hazard they will tell you (most often it is a result of cooking in the kitchen).

Be aware that LKV has the local 'plane alarm' (flyalarm) located at the loft. This is tested now and then, and is very loud. The test is always at 12 pm and the signal they are using means 'turn on your radio to get information'.


